

Former Cochran Commissioner Dies

MORTON (Special) — Funeral services for C. G. (Charlie) Shaw, former county commissioner who died early today in the Cochran County Hospital of injuries suffered in an automobile accident Monday, were pending at the Singleton Funeral Home here.

Shaw was 60.

He was one of four former county officials who were indicted by a grand jury here last Saturday, after an audit of county funds had been instituted.

Survivors include the widow, of Morton; four sons, Seth of Bula, Vernon of Morton, Bill and Fred of Carlsbad, N. M.; and a daughter whose address was not listed.

Shaw had resided in Morton about 25 years. He came to Morton from Crosbyton. He served eight years as a commissioner and had resided in New Mexico before returning to Morton recently.

He suffered rib injuries in the accident Monday—a two-car collision at the intersection of two dirt rural roads, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north and 3 miles west of Morton. His vehicle overturned after the crash.

Shaw's condition was not reported serious at first and Tuesday he had been reported in "pretty good condition." Six ribs were broken in the accident and he suffered cuts and bruises.
