(Special) — Services were to be conducted at 2 p. m. today at the Singleton Funeral home chapel here for Guadalupe Seranno, six - month - old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Locio Seranno, who was burned to death about 10:30 a. m. Thursday when flames destroyed her family's temporary home in a grain storage barn constructed of two railroad boxcars.

The fire took place at the C. R. Woolsey farm six miles north and four miles west of Morton.

Slight facial and hand burns were suffered by the child's mother when she made an attempt to rush into the burning structure. She was pulled back just before the roof fell in.

Destroyed along with the building was \$3,000 worth of grain and farm equipment stored in one of the cars.
