



Morton Rites Set For L. G. Warlick

MORTON (Special) — Funeral services for L. G. Warlick, 80, who died Tuesday at Methodist Hospital in Lubbock, were to be held at 2 p.m. today in the First Methodist Church here.

The Rev. J. E. Harrell, pastor, was to officiate. Burial was to be at Tech Memorial Park in Lubbock under direction of Singleton Funeral Home of Morton.

Warlick and his wife had been residents of a Lubbock nursing home since January, 1957. Before then, both had been Morton residents since 1951. A native of Stringtown, Okla., Warlick had lived in Eastern New Mexico and West Texas most of his life.

In 1900, Warlick was married to the former Miss Minnie Pearl Roswell in Childress. She died in 1903. Later, Warlick was married to the former Miss Mary Garrison, who survives.

Other survivors include a son, L. M. Warlick, Hobbs; a daughter, Mrs. Pearl Kings, Truth or Consequences, N. M.; a sister, Mrs. Lela Williams, Matador; two half-brothers, John Warlick, San Diego, Calif., and Walter Warlick, Maryland; and four grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.
