## **Tournament Rules 2023: Cochran County 100-year celebration Volleyball Competition**

1. Games will be refereed by rotation volunteer officials. All calls by the officials are final. No arguing. It's for charity!
2. Teams limited to 10 players. Age range 10yooa – 100+ yoa 😊 Coaches may be added on team as long as they do not play. (Minimum of 4 girls on each team, 2 girls on sand at all playing times)
3. Team names, roster, and waivers are due by: April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024, see attached roster sheet.
4. Once a roster has been submitted those players are no longer eligible to pay for another team. A pickup player can be used once if team is short a player, but must already be on a team roster within the league.
5. \$10 fee for late sign ups.
6. Games are played to 21 points or 30 minutes, (15minute intervals) whoever is winning when time is done by rally scoring; win by two, with a 23-point cap. Rally scoring means there is a point for every serve. Teams will switch sides when the first team reaches 11 points.
7. \$3.00 Mulligan ticket (limit 6 per team, for entire tournament, must be purchases right before each game by ref. on cite). Mulligans can be used for offensive of defensive plays, must be submitted immediately after play to referee). (Mulligans reverse a play)
8. Winners will be determined by team record throughout the head-to-head competition.
9. Players will rotate in at the right, back position (server) on each rotation. A rotation must occur after each side-out and in the same order throughout the game. Players MUST remain in their rotated spot during each play.. (Failure to do so, will give other team an automatic point)
10. A "let" serve that clears the net is considered playable. The receiving team may not block or spike a serve. The server's feet may not touch the court lines until after contact has been made with the volleyball.
11. Players are not permitted to touch the net. Incidental contact of the net by a player's hair or insignificant contact with the net by a player not involved in the action is not considered a fault. A player may touch the posts, ropes or other objects outside the total length of the net, provided this does not interfere with play. If a player touches the net, the opposing team gets the point and the serve. This shall be determined at the sole discretion of the official.
12. Players may use any part of their body to volley so long as such contact with the ball does not constitute a "carry" or a "lift". A "block" is not considered a team hit and after "block" contact, a team is entitled to three hits to return the ball. The player who made the block may also make the first contact in the same series.
13. Court lines are considered "IN".
14. If the ball touches the antennas or any part of the net outside the playing court, the play is immediately ruled dead and the point will go to the receiving team.
15. No shoes, no shirt, no volley.
16. Snacks and Beverages will be sold at the tournament location.
17. All players must sign the waiver form before stepping on the court. Failure to do so will result in an automatic forfeit for any team not abiding by this rule.
